## Competition format

### 28-29 of November 2024 – Pole Sport

World Championships all categories: Amateurs, Competitive & Para

### 30 of November and 1 of December 2024 – Aerial Sport

World Championships all categories: Amateurs, Competitive & Para

The starting order of the competition will be made between the 8th and 12 of November 2024 by the official representatives of POSA after the deadline for athlete applications (31 October 2024) has closed.

If a National Federation reduces the number of participating athletes after the definitive inscriptions, POSA/TC has the right to adjust the starting order to ensure the best possible running of the competition.

## Qualifications for the European Championship & World Championships 2025

## POSA Championships Finals & "Passport Rules"

The top ten in each category will qualify for the finals.

- No more than **two** (2) athletes per country (same nationality) are admitted to the final. This means that only the first two athletes from the same country will be admitted to the final. In case of more than two athletes from the same nation in the top ten semifinals, the next athletes of different nationalities in the ranking will then be admitted to the final until a total of 10 athletes are reached.
- In case of a tie at any position at the end of the qualifications see *POSA Code of Points*.
- *This rule could also be applied to Aerial's competition, should there be a need to organize semifinals and finals.*
- The list of the finalists, including two reserves, will be handed over to the head of the delegation after each qualification. Starting order of the final, is made according to the draw of lots carried out in Olympic Training Center of Tirrenia (Italy), on the 17th of February 2024, by the official representatives of the POSA

## Awards ceremonies

The ceremonies at the competition venue will take place as mentioned in the schedule.

## Aerial Supplier and Equipment

Official Sponsor of Aerial Equipment is **Apole Company**.

The competition stage will be equipped with professional aerial equipment: 7 meters high open-topped. For the preparation of the routine, account must be taken of the subtraction of 30 cm for the coupling device and the height of the mat. This way the maximum usable height is 6.30 meters for the silk and hammock and 6.50 for the hoop.

All athletes are requested to bring their apparatus (Silk, Hammock and/or Hoop)

**Apole Company** will provide a Hoop (standard size) and a Silk, however we recommend that you bring your own apparatus.

Crash Mat 200\*200 meters 20 cm thick (Mandatory)

Crash Mat 200\*200 meters 40 cm thick will be also available.

## Pole Sport equipment

The competition poles will be supplied by **Apole Company** and will correspond to the requirements of the Code of Points 2024.

## Access to the competition area

The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the POSA Medical Commission, the official doctor, the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the athletes and coaches during all Competitions.

## Scoring and distribution of results

Once the competition has finished, by request, all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results (Difficulty only) by e-mail. However, requests must be sent to the international federation within one week after the end of the competition, after that date, it will no longer be possible. (Please refer carefully to the Rules & Regulations 2024).

**Please note** feedback may only be requested from the Head Judges after the award ceremony of the category in which the athlete competed or at the end of the competition.

It is strictly forbidden to approach the jury table during competitions.

For any queries or appeals during the competition, athletes and/or coaches must contact the Superior Jury (please read the procedures described in this Workplan carefully).

## List of difficulty elements

As specified in COP 2024, the athlete who changes something in the declaration of the elements, must bring the new Difficulty Sheets in 8 copies directly to the competition.

- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category.

## File must be in pdf format

**Warning:** Incorrectly named Difficulty Sheets will receive a deduction from the Head Judge (as per the Code of Points). Handwritten or illegible difficulty sheets or photographs of the sheet are not accepted. In this case a penalty will be imposed on the athlete for incorrectly completed difficulty sheets.

After sending the difficulty sheet, further submissions will not be accepted. In case of further changes, the difficulty sheet can be handed over to the Head Judge at the competition

## Music

To limit the technical problems with the music used for the competitions, the Organizing Committee has decided to only accept the athletes' music in an MP3 format only. All music used during the World Pole and Aerial Sports Championships 2024 must be submitted online.

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category;
- The length of the music;
- (Example: ROU\_ RADU\_Alina\_Junior\_IW\_3min30s\_mp3)

In addition, the competitors need to bring their music with them to the venue on the competition day on an USB stick as a backup.

Attention: Incorrectly named music file will receive a warning from the Head Judge (as per the Code of Points).

## Doping control

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control can be done to the athletes at any time, without a pre-warning, in accordance with POSA regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA regulations.

## THE JURY

### **Jury Composition**

Jury A/B

- 1 Head Judge fixed by Draw
- 2 Difficulty Judges fixed by Draw
- 5 Artistic Judges fixed by Draw
- 5 Execution Judge fixed by Draw

### **Inquiries procedure**

Inquiries for the difficulty scores will be allowed if they are made verbally immediately after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the end of the routine of the following athlete (then 4 minutes). For the last athlete of a rotation (rotation=group of athletes, for example, 1st Group of athletes during the competition is called "rotation"), this limit is one minute after the score is shown on the scoreboard.

The person designated to receive the verbal inquiry will have to note the time of receiving it, which will start the procedure. Only the accredited coaches present in the competition area will be entitled to submit an inquiry. Late verbal inquiries will be rejected.

A Federation will not be allowed to complain against an athlete from another federation. The inquiry will have to be confirmed in writing as soon as possible, but at the latest within 4 minutes after the verbal inquiry and will require an agreement of payment of EUR 150— for the first complaint, EUR 300 — for the second complaint, and EUR 600— for the third complaint. Should the inquiry not be confirmed in writing within 4 minutes, then the procedure will become obsolete.

Should the inquiry prove correct and be accepted, this sum will be reimbursed. Every inquiry will be examined immediately by the Superior Jury and a final decision, which may not be appealed, will be made very soon, at the very latest:

- At the end of the rotation for the qualifying competitions, or at the end of all-around competitions.
- Before the score of the following athlete is shown for the finals.

The detailed procedure is laid down in the respective POSA Code of Points.

### **Tie-breaking rule.**

In case of a tie at any position at the end of a competition see POSA Code of Points.

### **Delegations**

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the World Pole Sport & Aerial Championship 2024:

- 1. Athletes matching the guidelines of the 2024 Rules & Regulations (Pole Sport & Aerial)**
- 2. The first 3 classified (Amateurs and Competitive) of the 2023 and/or 2024 National Pole & Aerial Championships (Depending on when the qualifying competition was organized)**
- 3. All those automatically admitted by the International Federation (Wild Card Athletes).**

The International Federation, together with the LOC, has decided to admit the Junior Varsity Amateur and Competitive categories, both Pole Sport and Aerial Sport, to the competition.

### **Registration and accreditation**

Each athlete needs to have a competition WHEA/POSA license with approved anti-doping contract 2024.

Athletes must do their registration at latest on 28th of October. All documentation must be sent by the deadline to [posachampionship@gmail.com](mailto:posachampionship@gmail.com)

The documents to be sent by e-mail are:

- Competitive medical certificate (8 years and older)
- Identity card
- AICS membership card (only for Italian athletes) and private insurance for foreign athletes
- Athlete registration form by national federation
- For those registered in the aerial sport section: SELF-DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE OF FITNESS EQUIPMENT
- Bank Transfer for photo and video, spectator tickets and entry fee (athlete and coach)

Please send all documents in one email.

Accreditation permits the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Accreditation bracelet must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. The accreditation bracelet is personal, non-transferable, and necessary to access the training and competition halls.

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. During the accreditation the athletes and/or the Heads of Delegations will verify the identity of the members of their delegation. To get the accreditation all members of the delegation must have fulfilled all the necessary financial obligations (including insurance).

POSA Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially to the number of persons accredited per nation.

### **Training information**

The training will start at the competition stage on Wednesday 27th of November. Training will be reserved only for Pole Sport section.

Access to the competition hall, the training and the warm-up halls will only be granted to the delegations wearing the accreditation card and only during the times reserved for their nation.

### **Opening ceremony**

The Official Opening Ceremony for Pole Sport athletes will be held on November 28th for all Pole Sport categories, in the Competition Hall.

The Official Opening Ceremony for Aerial Sport athletes will be held on November 30th for all Aerial Sport categories in the Competition Hall.

The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing a special greeting for the audience. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit.

All delegations must have the National Flag (dimension of 100/200 cm) with them on Opening ceremony.

The opening ceremony is mandatory.

At least five athletes per delegation must be present at the ceremony.

## Competition Area

Access to the competition area

- The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, local group leaders, auxiliary personnel of the Jury, the Medical Commission, and persons concerned with the apparatus.
- Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the President of Posa.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.
- The use of any kind of electronic devices (video, mobile phones, etc.) is strictly forbidden in the competition area. Please note that, according to the decision of the Executive Committee of POSA, if a mobile phone or any other electronic communication device is used in the competition area during the entire competition, the person concerned (athlete and/or coach) will be immediately expelled. The athlete will not be ranked and will not be authorized to participate in the remaining competitions. If this rule is violated by a coach, all his/her athletes will also be expelled.

Professional photographing and filming of the performances are under written permission from the organizing committee.
