Rehearsals stage Pole Art:

The stage rehearsals will be without music, each athlete will have 1.30 minutes to rehearse the stage, each delegation will be sent the rehearsals programme divided by each national delegation.

The Led Wall will be present to project any photo and video material during the athletes' performance (for those who wish to make use of it).

Please note during the rehearsals stage (Friday), it will still not be possible to have the Led Wall working.

Those who wish to check their video will have to contact the technicians.

We recommend, however, that you send the Head of Delegation to inform the technicians of the names of those who wish to check their videos.

Qualifications

The starting order of the competition (qualifications) will be made between the 28th and 30th of November 2023 by the official representatives of POSA after the deadline for athlete applications (5th of November) has closed. If a National Federation reduces the number of participating athletes after the definitive inscriptions, POSA/TChas the right to adjust the starting order to ensure the best possible running of the competition. **Warning: For some countries, a period of extension of this deadline will apply due to the date of their National Pole Art Championship.**

Qualifications for the World Pole Art Championship 2024

The top 3 athletes (**in each Elite category**) in the ranking have the right to participate in the World Pole Art Championship 2024.



Access to the competition area

- The competition area is accessible to the members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the President of the POSA Medical Commission, the official doctor, the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus. A team medical person is permitted to accompany the athletes and coaches during all Competitions.
- Interpreters may not enter the competition area without the permission of the President of POSA/TC.
- Only POSA-accredited coaches, or coaches accredited by their national federation affiliated to POSA, may enter the competition area.
- Heads of delegation may enter the competition area at any time, but coaches must leave the competition area as soon as their athlete's score has been announced.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.
- The use of any kind of electronic devices (video, mobile phones, etc.) is strictly forbidden in the competition area. Please note that, according to the decision of the Executive Committee of POSA, if a mobile phone or any other electronic communication device is used in the competition area during the entire competition, the person concerned (athlete and/or coach) will be immediately expelled. The athlete will not be ranked and will not be authorized to participate in the remaining competitions. If this rule is violated by a coach, all his/her athletes will also be expelled.
- Professional photographing and filming the performances are under written permission by the organizing committee

Awards ceremonies

The ceremonies in the competition venue will take place as mentioned in the time schedule.

Poles supplier

The competition podium and training hall have the official POSA poles supplied by **A-Pole** only. Stainless 45mm. Competition stage pole height 4 meters. In the training hall there are several A-Pole stainless 45mm stages available along with other warm-up choices.

Scoring and distribution of results

Once the competition has finished, all delegations will be provided with a complete set of results on our federal site.



Music

To limit the technical problems with the music used for the competitions, the Organizing Committee has decided to only accept the athletes' music in an MP3 format only, and video in MP4 format only.

Athletes must send their music and/or video by **26th November** to this email:

Each music/video file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category;
- The length of the music;
- (Example: ROU_ RADU_Alina_Junior_IW_3min30s_mp3) If you need help, please contact us at: generalsecretary@posaworld.org

In addition, the competitors need to bring their music with them to the venue on the competition days on an USB stick as a backup.

Doping control

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control can be done to the athletes at any time, without a pre-warning, in accordance with POSA regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA regulations.

Each athlete needs to have a competition WHEA/POSA license with approved anti-doping contract.

Delegations

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the World pole Art Championship:

1. The top 3 Élite classified of the 2022 World Pole Art Championships
2. The top 3 Elite classified of the 2022 Pole Art POSA competitions around the World
3. The first 3 Elite classified of the 2022 POSA National Pole Art Championships
4. The first 3 classified (Amateurs) of the 2022 POSA National Pole Art Championships & Pole Art POSA competitions around the World.
5. All those automatically admitted by the international federation (Wild Card Athletes).

Registration and accreditation

Accreditation permits the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Accreditation card must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. The accreditation card is personal, non-transferable, and necessary to access the training and competition halls, as well as for official transports.

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. During the accreditation the athletes and/or the Heads of Delegations will verify the identity of the members of their delegation. To get the accreditation all members of the delegation must have fulfilled all the necessary financial obligations (including insurance). Upon accreditation, the Head of Delegation or their representative will have to bring a copy of the Medical Certificate/Diploma for medical personnel. POSA will collect and record these certificates. Please note that without this document, the accreditation of the medical personnel will NOT be released.

POSA Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially to the number of persons accredited per nation.

Please note: in the absence of the Head of Delegation, accreditation may also be carried out by a coach for the rest of the team or for a group of athletes from that team.

Training information

The training will start in the training hall (not the stage, but training hall, in the backstage) and at the competition stage on Friday 8th Dec.

Access the competition hall, the training and the warm-up halls will only be granted to the delegations wearing the accreditation card and only during the times reserved for their nation.

Opening ceremony

Each delegation will have to choose at least one athlete who will take part in the parade of nations.

The Official Opening Ceremony will be held on December 9th for all categories, in the Competition Hall. The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing a special greeting for the audience. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit. All delegations must have the National Flag (dimension of 100/200 cm) with them on Opening ceremony.

Medical services

The LOC will provide the necessary medical services.

Transportation

For judges, a private shuttle service is provided on Friday and Sunday from and to the airport.

Insurance

POSA Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations or athletes must assume all costs in relation to the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Local Organising Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy).

Entering the World Championships without a valid medical insurance for all delegation members will be rejected.

Visa

Please check whether you need a visa to enter Spain. The Local Organising Committee will gladly assist you in applying for a visa. The assist must be requested no later than 1st November from contact@posaworld.org


